2. Chapter Readiness Quizzes: Quizzes that assess your understanding on concepts to be learned in a chapter.
3. Standardized Test Practice: Questions to give you practice with multiple choice using chapter content.
4. Chapter Test: A multiple choice practice test to help you prepare for the chapter test.
